2012 Project Highlights:

Provincial Knowledge Translation Strategy and Implementation

Funder: Ontario Renal Network

• CEP is helping the Ontario Renal network (ORN) to create a program strategy for the early detection (screening) and management of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) as well as execute the subsequent strategic plan. To date, CEP has worked with ORN to design and implement a pilot mentoring/shared care program in Ontario to link primary care providers to nephrologist specialists to build collaborative relationships and increase access to nephrology support in order to ensure better care for patients in Ontario. In addition, CEP is currently assisting ORN with designing an EMR pilot program to test point of care tools to better enable evidence-based screening, management and referral of CKD patients.

Integrated Cancer Screening Strategy Implementation

Funder: Cancer Care Ontario

Cancer Care Ontario's (CCO) Integrated Cancer Screening strategy (ICS) is undergoing program
redesign to emphasize prevention and enhance family health care screening. The ICS strategy
integrates existing breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer screening guidelines into primary care to
support patients, providers, and health system planners in improving the quality and uptake of
screening.

 CEP has been engaged by CCO to develop, test and disseminate, including the engagement of key stakeholders, the highest quality preventive screening tools for providers, positively influencing health outcomes in the province of Ontario.

EMR Implementation Support

Funder: Hamiliton Family Health Team

• The Hamilton Family Health Team (HFHT) has engaged the Centre for Effective Practice (CEP) to provide implementation support for Chronic Non-Cancer Pain (CNCP) EMR modules for two vendors user groups: Bell and Practice Solutions Suite. This project supports the Quality Improvement plans at various practices at HFHT to better provide evidence-based care for their patients with CNCP. This work builds upon a previous pilot project CEP conducted with eHealth Ontario, the Core Care practice of HFHT and its EMR vendor Xwave/Bell in which CEP developed and implemented a process to integrate CNCP clinical practice guideline recommendations into their EMR.
