



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
## Results of a 2017/2018 needs assessment survey of primary care providers in Ontario:

Respondents were asked to select up to three priority topic areas.





### HIGHEST RANKED SUB-TOPICS BY INTEREST<sup>2</sup>:

A needs assessment survey was emailed to primary care providers in Ontario via the Ontario College of Family Physicians and the Nurse Practitioners' Association of Ontario. The survey was available for seven weeks and 621 valid responses were received. The sample size for each question presented above varies.

[1] Interest in receiving a clinical tool for a clinical topic area was determined by survey respondents selecting and ranking up to three top preferences from a list of 14 pre-determined clinical topic areas. Percentages represent those who selected the topic area in their top three preferences.  
[2] Survey respondents were asked to select the sub-topic that most interests them from a list of pre-determined sub-topic areas for each topic they selected.  
[3] This category is a combination of multiple related categories ("Rural", "Small town", "Remote").
