### Impact at a Glance

This year, CEP moved primary care forward with trusted, cost-saving solutions that support clinicians, improve patient care and accelerate health system transformation.



**20,000** clinicians turned to CEP as a trusted resource, including close to **50%** of primary care clinicians in Ontario.



**80+** stakeholders were meaningfully engaged and provided input into a comprehensive evaluation of Ontario's interprofessional care teams.



Academic Detailing helped family physicians and nurse practitioners switch nearly **50% more patients** to lower-cost insulin biosimilars, cutting costs in half compared to biologic insulins.



With ~1,000 tailored educational coaching sessions (Academic Detailing) across Ontario, CEP is helping transform frontline care. 99% of clinicians say our education improves their patient care.



A pan-Canadian initiative helped **93%** of clinicians align with best practices for patients with chronic pain, mental health, and substance use conditions.

To support system readiness, CEP launched Canada's first AI Learning Centre for primary care, a free hub co-designed with clinicians and experts to build AI literacy and confidence.
