An Innovative Balanced Scorecard for Quality in Diabetes Care

Academic endocrinologists from five University of Toronto hospitals have come together on a quality initiative in order to develop a set of appropriate indicators to measure the quality of diabetes care. In order to establish a list of indicators across the six domains of quality, a modified Delphi panel process will be used, with a specific focus on extensive patient engagement throughout the process.

The CEP team has been engaged in phase one of this initiative, to conduct a search for existing indicators, which will be considered in the modified Delphi Panel process.

CIHI New Health **Indicators**

The Canadian Institute for Health information (CIHI) and Statistics Canada have recently issued a set of 27 new indicators measuring health system and patient outcomes.

New indicators include 30-day stroke in-hospital mortality, 30day surgical readmission, patients with repeat hospitalizations for mental illness, and caesarean section rate.
